SYNOPSIS

Detective “Medina” is a highly-decorated twenty-three year homicide investigator, whose final case fails to stop an elusive serial killer targeting the local elderly. Despite her rapidly declining mental fortitude, she continues to piece together clues and believes the murderer is someone she knows. Early stage dementia, self-awareness or guilt could be preventing her from turning in the suspect. The killer’s profession as a hospice worker grants him access to victims’ family.
