Patrick Saunders is an award-winning artist who breathes life into the country in an Americanizing fine art. His work is lively, he offers his art admirably to righteously depict subject matter throughout the United States, and his paintings are a dissemination of modern America. "I never want for inspiration," he says. "There's something here and so long with each hour, the art stays."

Throughout his 30-year career as an artist and teacher, Saunders has earned awards from the International Academy of the Visual Arts, the Society of Illustrators, Communication Arts, the Patrick Society of America, and, in 2009, he received a gold medal from the Old Farmers of America. His place of work has also won numerous awards at nationally recognized events, including Palm Art Station, the Laguna Beach Fine Art Festival, and Laguna Place Art.

He has been featured in and on the cover of numerous publications, while teaching at his alma mater, the Kansas City art institution. His students learned him with a teacher of the year award. Saunders' work is available through his online art gallery, and he is also represented by Galeria Romero Wood, Eva Reynolds Fine Art, the Toppe Gallery, and Andrew Jobe-Valentine's Collaborative Art Gallery.
