Afterworld: Zen Garden, AARC (Asian American Resource Center), April 2023 - An immersive installation that seeks to celebrate multiculturalism and diversity, drawing inspiration from afterlife beliefs across different cultures (such as Obon and Day of the Dead) to create a space of inclusivity and understanding for all ages and backgrounds, where we can recognize and appreciate the commonality of our shared experiences, and gain a deeper understanding of one another.

Afterworld: Presa House Gallery, San Antonio (October 2022) - A multicultural art installation that explores traditional autumn celebrations through digital works, altar displays, video, and light experimentation.

I AM YOUR RELATIVE: The Museum of Contemporary Art Toronto (May 2022) - An exhibition by Jeffrey Gibson that amplifies underrepresented narratives and uplifts historically silenced voices, featuring public submissions of digitally rendered visual media.

Fusebox Festival: Austin, TX (April 2022) - A showcase of art direction, graphic design, and a flag installation by our collective.

Interwoven Throughout Eternity: Ivester Contemporary Gallery, Austin, TX (September-October 2021) - A series of digital photographs and collages that explore the interconnectivity of the human and non-human, created during the pandemic.

San Antonio Street Art Initiative: Large-scale photographic murals installed as public art in Downtown San Antonio, sponsored by Pabst Blue Ribbon (April 2021)

Commodore Perry Estate: Austin, TX (December 2020, 2021) - A projection of visuals on the Commodore Perry building for an outdoor holiday event.

Biochromatic: San Antonio, TX (November 2017) - Biochromatic, loosely meaning "light produced by living organisms", encompasses curiosities whose luminescence is unfamiliar, and the wholly human venture of illumination.
