El Camarón: A Musical History – San Antonio Public Library Latino Collection & Resource Center – Central Library – 3/25/2023 – Presenter/Performer - Presented songs from my new EP "El Camarón," covering an often overlooked event in local history. Through my new album, I invite listeners to explore the circumstances surrounding the case of Clemente Apolinar, the last man hanged at the old Bexar County Jail on Camaron Street in 1923. This presentation explored the misconceptions surrounding Apolinar and the case, including racial injustice and the social climate of the times, the damage that familial/community silence and stigma can do to the historical narrative, and the role musical tradition plays in documenting events in our history.
