Narrative: The Mural was created for Centro San Antonio's " Art Everywhere" initiative. The mural honors indigenous cultures and underground artists.

It stands 70 feet wide and roughly 100 feet tall. The mural portrays a native American woman, her heart as a guiding light, riding a blue deer, which is a common element in indigenous culture, symbolizing medical and spiritual rituals. The deer stepping off the cliff symbolizes the artist stepping into a new creative journey and taking an unknown risk.
